As the end of this legislative session approaches, the State House continues to hold formal sessions on bills pending in the legislature, and community meetings and events in the district proceed as the warmer weather picks up.

Since the last newsletter, we in the House passed several bills, including H.4703, "An Act Reforming the Administrative Procedures Relative to Criminal Offender Record Information" (CORI reform), H.4156, "An Act Relative to the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote," and H.4744, "An Act to Regulate the Use of Off-Highway and Recreation Vehicles." As you may know, both the House and Senate budget debates for the 2011 fiscal year came to a close and the Conference Committee in which the final budget is established will occur at the end of this month. I will continue to work to make certain funding is appropriated to the priorities of this district, as well as for the benefit of public health.
